

## A way to access “daikoku” from an Windows PC (Recommended)

(At the time of 2022.10.05)

### Softwares to be installed:

- PuTTY: Remote-logon terminal client software
- VcXsrv: X server

### PuTTY

Installation

Unzip the download zip file or 7z file.

Minimum required Settings

- Session Host Name (or IP address)  
Enter “daikoku.seis.nagoya-u.ac.jp”
- Connection > Data Auto-login username Enter your username.
- Connection > SSH > X11 Check “” Enable X11 forwarding
- Session Saved Sessions Enter “daikoku” and press “Save”  
Double-click “daikoku” or press “daikoku”, “Open”, then you can connect to “daikoku”.

### VcXsrv

Installation

Search “VcXsrv install”, then you can find many sites. Installation is easy.

### After installation and setting

- Start VcXsrv, then start PuTTY.
- Connect to “daikoku” with your password.
- When you can successfully login, try below.

```
-bash-4.2$ xeyes &
```

If eyes appear on your screen, everything was done well.
